

1.5 CHAPTER RELATIONSHIP TO MLA

The bylaws state, under Article 2 Purpose: that MLGSCA “maintain regional affiliation with the Medical Library Association (MLA).” Following are the current activities which provide liaison with MLA:

- A. An Annual Report prepared by the President is forwarded to MLA in the Spring, and it is published for the MLA Annual Meeting. During the year the President prepares a statement of objectives and a mid-year progress report which are sent to MLA.
- B. The Nominating Committee presents one or two candidates to the Advisory Council for the MLGSCA nominee to the MLA Nominating Committee. The Advisory Council approves one candidate to forward to Chapter Council.
- C. Every three years MLGSCA elects a Chapter Council Representative and Alternate to represent MLGSCA on the MLA Chapter Council and to communicate Chapter Council activities to MLGSCA.
- D. The President informs MLA Headquarters of our annual election results.
- E. The President-Elect attends the New Leaders’ Breakout session for incoming Chapter Chairs at the MLA Annual Meeting.
- F. During the year in which MLGSCA is responsible for the Joint Meeting with NCNMLG, a request is made to have an MLA officer or board member speak at the meeting.
- G. The Public Relations Committee and MLA Chapter Council Representative submit items on MLGSCA events or meetings to the *MLA NEWS*.
- H. The Continuing Education/Program Committee coordinates plans for sponsoring MLA CE courses.
- I. The newly-elected President Elect should try to attend the Chapter Continuing Education Chairs’ session at the MLA Annual Meeting.
