My responsibilities

- → Purchase physical & digital books
 → Oversight of physical collection
 → Weeding
 → Collection Development Cmte

Collection profile

- → 374,643 physical items
 → 180,837 unique monographic titles (40% digital)
 → 13,019 serial titles (60% digital)

Current acquisitions = 95% digital





GreenGlass

- → Analyzes a library's collection and compares it to all libraries with holdings in OCLC.
- → Incorporates circulation and shelving data
- → Snapshot in time of a library's collection, what's unique and been used
- → Dashboard for queries and graphical display of data

Weeding at Lane

- → No formal, systematic weeding process in place
- → A resource library for health sciences
- → Pitched GreenGlass to CDC
- → Paid for it with OCLC credits
- → Commissioned analysis in early 2020



COVID Shutdown

Library closed March 202August 2021

Significant budget cuts in 2020/2021

GreenGlass analysis was completed in June 2020



No weeding could be done with no one in the library —or could it?



Newark –Our offsite storage problem



- ❖ 18,500 books
- 30,000 foreign dissertations

Proposed to CDC

- → Empty Newark and discontinue lease
- → Weed and save more in long term storage fees



Using GreenGlass to Weed Newark


- 1. Identify titles where Lane is the only CA library to own the edition
 - Move to the new storage facility first
- 1. Identify titles with no circulation history that are widely held elsewhere
 - Key librarians would review list
 - Weed the titles from collection
- 1. Move the remaining titles to new facility





Using GreenGlass to Weed Newark

18,500 Items





Foreign Dissertations

CDC decided to find a new home

- Inadequate resources to catalog them
- Long-term high-density storage > \$15,000/annual costs

We contacted:

- The other Stanford libraries
- University of North Carolina
- Osler Library of the History of Medicine at McGill University
- Center for Research Libraries
- CadeususL listserv



Internet Archive

- → 8,000 weeded items
- → All foreign dissertations

By August 2021, Newark was empty!





Beyond Newark

- Completed weeding audiovisual materials
- Begun reference collection
